

San Antonio Potters' Guild Frank Gaudot Memorial Scholarship

Criteria

Purpose:

A scholarship was set up in 1997 honoring fellow potter Frank Gaudot, deceased. Frank was an integral part of the San Antonio potters' scene, a charter member of the San Antonio Potters' Guild (SAPG), and supported the Ceramics program of the Southwest School of Art & Craft (SSAC). The purpose of the scholarship is to support class tuition and/or supplies for clay artists needing support, to attend the SSAC Ceramics Department programs.

Guidelines:

At least once a year, funds permitting, the San Antonio Potters' Guild will award a full or partial scholarship for tuition and/or supplies to a talented, highly motivated individual.

Selection:

Selection will be made up of a committee headed by the President, SAPG and the Chair of the Ceramics Department SSAC. Applicants will be judged on an application and an essay, not more than 250 words, outlining the need for the award.

Application Deadline:

Frank Gaudot Memorial Scholarship applications must be submitted via email (ceramics@swschool.org) or hard copy 4 weeks prior to SSAC registration. Mailing address is SAPG, P.O. Box 460863, San Antonio, TX 78246-0863.

Scholarship Conditions:

Scholarship monies will be paid to the SSAC to supplement tuition for course work in the Ceramics Department. Recipients must, at the conclusion of the class, present a short wrap-up briefing on the semester's activities. The briefing will be at a General Meeting. Coordination of this presentation will be made through the Program Chairperson of the SAPG.

Individuals can only receive one scholarship every 3 years.

Applications must include:

1. Formal SAPG Frank Gaudot Memorial Scholarship Application
2. Essay detailing need for the award or other pertinent information (not more than 250 words)
3. Resume
